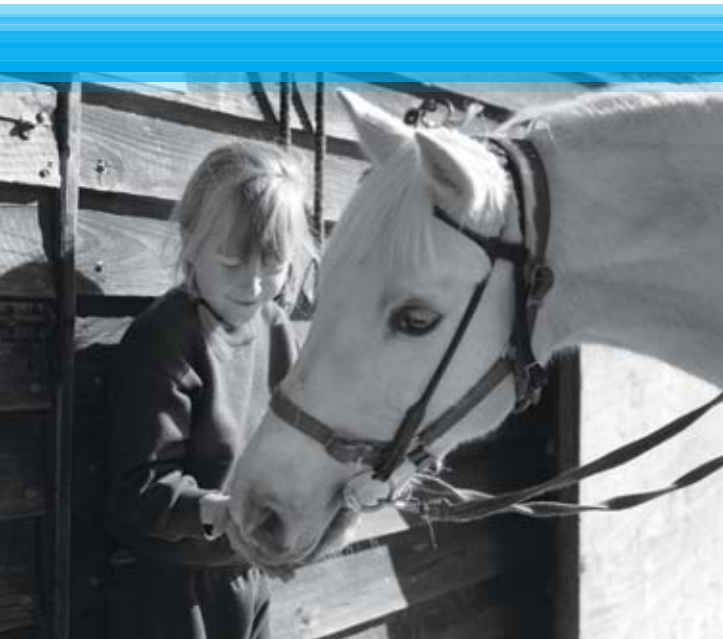


Testimonial from a donor

How to make a bequest to Pegasus

We regard your gift as a very personal and private decision and we suggest that you consult with your legal adviser and possibly use the following wording in your will.

I give...(specify dollar amount, life insurance policy number, shares or bonds, share of estate, detail of property or assets) to Pegasus Riding for the Disabled of the ACT (Inc).

Or: *I give.... (specify dollar amount, life insurance policy number, shares or bonds, share of estate, detail of property or assets) to Pegasus Riding for the Disabled ACT (Inc) for its own use absolutely.*

Or: *I give...(specify dollar amount, life insurance policy number, shares or bonds, share of estate, detail of property or assets) to be preserved as a capital sum generating annual income to the Pegasus Foundation.*

While we respect your privacy, we suggest that in order to ensure you achieve your desired outcome you first speak with the Executive Officer of Pegasus or the President of the Pegasus Management Committee in regard to the appropriate use of your gift.

What is the Pegasus Foundation?

The Pegasus Foundation has been established to support the work of Pegasus Riding for the Disabled Inc. The Foundation is a repository for funds received from donations, gifts, bequests and other fundraising activities. The Foundation invests these funds wisely to maximise returns. Foundation funds are then used to continue and expand Pegasus' service to the community.

Pegasus is a not-for-profit community organisation that provides equestrian activities for people with disabilities. The great majority of our riders are school aged children with a wide range of physical and intellectual disabilities.

Apart from being fun, horse riding helps to improve co-ordination, balance, muscle development and fitness. It also boosts personal confidence, self-esteem, communication skills, leadership and trust.

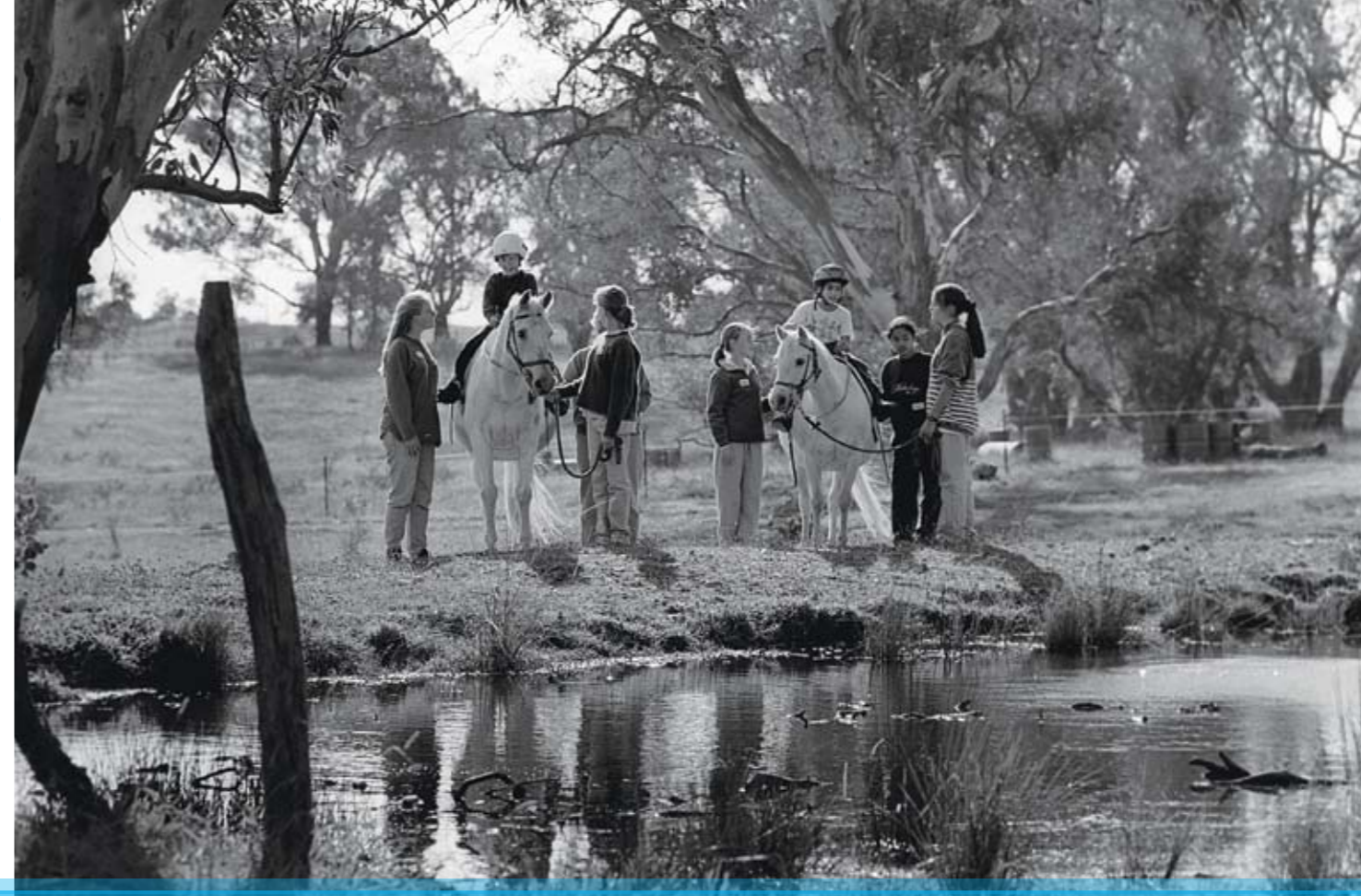
For over 30 years Pegasus has provided people with a disability the opportunity to enjoy the benefits of riding and a relationship with horses.

Due to the unstinting support of over 100 volunteers, Pegasus is able to provide this special opportunity to approximately 100 riders each week.

Pegasus horses are specially selected and trained at 'Pegasus Farm', which is a 100 acre leasehold property on Drake Brockman Drive in Holt. Keeping the property running, maintaining the horses, providing riding equipment and ensuring that the riding program is of the highest standard is an expensive and challenging task.

A Bequest is a gift nominated in a Will to a person and/or one or more organisations.

You may choose to leave your gift for general use by Pegasus, or prefer to have it spent on a nominated project, or you may wish to specify that it be preserved as a capital sum generating an annual income to the Pegasus Foundation.
